

Fujitsu becomes the first to achieve ISO 45001 by Bureau Veritas covering more than 100 territories

LONDON, United Kingdom. – 29 April, 2019 – Make Business, the business services division of Make UK (formerly EEF), has supported leading international information technology company, Fujitsu, in achieving the new standard ISO 45001, the first organisation to be awarded the new standard by

global testing, inspection and certification expert, Bureau Veritas.

Fujitsu EMEIA identified the international standard as a route to business-wide consistency and worked with Make Business to rewrite the management standard to meet its organisational needs.

Partnering with Make Business, Fujitsu effectively achieved its legal and language requirements and was able to cross borders to ensure compliance for its 140,000 employees, in over 100 territories.
